

Community Under Threat Pulls Together

Feldon Residents Against Wind Turbines (FRAWT) are delighted with the response by Bishops Itchington villagers' to a fighting fund event at the Memorial Hall.

Over £300 was raised on Saturday May 8, as residents sold nearly new items to villagers to help raise funds. All items were donated by FRAWT members and supporters, with rugs, plants, video games and books proving very popular.

This latest fund raising event demonstrates the determination by FRAWT to oppose and challenge the potential plan by Broadview Energy to install six 400 feet windturbines at the side of the Burton Dassett Country Park.

Last year Stratford District Council rejected a planning application by Broadview to erect a wind measuring mast on the site next to Knightcote Bottoms Lane and the Country Park. Broadview appealed to the Government Inspectorate against this decision and as part of the Government Inspector's considerations, he will visit the site next month.

After Broadview appealed, a large number of residents wrote to the Planning Inspector urging him to reject the appeal. Many of these **residents will be at the site when the Inspector visits at 3 pm on June 3.**
